THE CLASSICAL CODE

- 1. Concert hall is 'consecrated'
- 2. Audience pays to hear the music.
- 3. Performer is on the stage, audience in the hall.
- 4. Podium is lit (spotlights).
- 5. Audience is in street clothes, performers in gala.
- 6. Audience listens reverently to the music (doesn't chat, drink).
- 7. Music is museal (like a painting in a museum), not contemporary.
- 8. Performance is 'authentic' (as the composer intended it).
- 9. The ensemble is established (orchestra, string quartet, trio, etc.
- 10. Audience applauds for the performer (before and after).
