#### **CALL FOR PARTICIPATION**

Dear student colleagues, dear professors and mentors,

We are pleased to invite students from all departments of music academies to take part in the sixth International Creative Student Workshop *Knowledge Sharing 2022/2023* [Ciklus kreativnih radionica *Podijelimo znanje 2022/2023*], and present their research and creative ideas. The Workshop will be held on April 19<sup>th</sup> and 20<sup>th</sup> of 2023.

The Department of Music Theory and Pedagogy of the Academy of Music, University of Sarajevo implements the project named Cycle of Creative Workshops *Knowledge Sharing* 2022/2023, within which the International Creative Student Workshop *Knowledge Sharing* 2022/2023 is being realized for the sixth time. The main idea of the Workshop is to encourage students of music to think creatively, acquire and expand their knowledge on music, linking it to related fields and observing it from different aspects. Finally, it is created to offer resources and space to students in order to present their formalized ideas publically, with the professional and methodological help of their mentors and professors as well. Presenting acquired knowledge and experiences from both theoretical and practical areas of musical fields is realized in the form of 15-min long individual or group presentations.

The project was created on the initiative of teachers and assistants of the Department of Music Theory and Pedagogy in the 2016/17 academic year. Since then, the Cycle has been regularly held every year, and over time new editions have been added: *Knowledge Sharing – Another Perspective*, *Alumni Edition*, *MAS Students on Tour* and *Piano Edition*. All the programs of this year's Cycle are realized in cooperation with the Center of Music Education of the Academy of Music, University of Sarajevo and the Department of Art, Artistic Research, Culture and Sports of the University of Sarajevo.

### **Technical information**

The Workshop application contains:

- filled application form containing the title of the topic, a summary (up to 200 words), keywords (3 to 5) and the biography of the author with the indication of the department and year of study (up to 100 words).
- the author's photo (min. 1000x1000 px).
- the mentor's written approval with the institutional letterhead. The mentor's consent should be written including the following information: first and last name of the student, department, title of the topic, motive. The signed and scanned approval should be sent by the mentor to one of the email addresses listed in the Call for Participation. Without the consent of the mentor, the application will not be taken into consideration.

- The topic can be submitted by a single author or a team of authors.
- Official languages of the Workshop are Bosnian/Serbian/Croatian and English.
- Authors will be informed about the acceptance of the topic by March 7<sup>th</sup> 2023.
